Introduction

- **Harassment:** Any form of harassment, including offensive comments, deliberate intimidation, stalking, unwelcome attention, and inappropriate physical contact.
- **Discrimination:** Discriminatory jokes, comments, or behavior based on personal characteristics.
- **Disruption:** Disruptive behavior during sessions, workshops, or networking events.
- Unwelcome Advances: Unsolicited sexual attention or advances.
- Inappropriate Use of Imagery: The use of sexualized images, activities, or other material in presentations or on social media.

Reporting and Response

- Confidentiality: All reports will be handled with discretion and confidentiality.
- **Investigation:** The conference committee will promptly investigate all reported incidents.
- Consequences: Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior are expected to comply immediately. If a participant engages in harassing behavior, the conference organizers may take any action they deem appropriate, including warning the offender or expulsion from the conference with no refund.
